With my programming background, experience in implementing software solutions, and ability to work in dynamic environments, I can excel as a business technology analyst at Deloitte.

I have encountered numerous programming languages not just in classes but through my work experience. I have developed software using Python, C#, XML, MXML, ActionScript, and HTML, and this wide range all came in just four semesters of work at Georgia Tech Research Institute, where I was a co-op. The advantage of learning the languages outside of a classroom environment was the chance for me to use just my background knowledge to quickly and independently adapt to these new languages. This helped hone my ability to learn and work independently without much supervision. In fact, my first task working for GTRI was to add a feature in the software they were developing in Python, a language I had never worked with. Also, when the programming aspect of my job moved on to the testing and implementation phase, I was able to work at the client's site, which was at the Marine's base at Camp Pendleton.

Working with the marines, my team experienced changing application requirements and worked to come up with solutions that can be implemented the very next day, or even just after lunch! I enjoyed the interactions we had with clients because it gave me an opportunity to see and hear first hand from them what they would like to see and what they did not find helpful in the applications. This, of course in turn, helped me understand the needs of our client better and what our goals for the next phase will be. The experience led me to value client interaction and taught me how important communication between the client and the development team is. In addition, each time I worked at the clients' sites, they were dynamic environments with changing requirements and test plans. When application requirements changed, I worked to implement those changes on site with limited resources. I learned not to panic when test plans get changed at the last minute and to prepare for such events by communicating with the clients and prepare multiple options if possible in your test plan. My work experience taught me how to operate at a fast paced and dynamic work environment, and more importantly, how to enjoy it.
